Athens County Board of Elections
Regular Meeting
August 16, 2023, 3:30 pm

The Athens County Board of Elections met on August 16, 2023 at 3:30 pm at the board office. The meeting was called to order by Board Chair Pettey, Roll Call – Aundrea S. Carpenter-Colvin, Gary Van Meter, Sky Pettey and Kate McGuckin all present. Also present at the meeting: Deputy Director Tony Brooks, Helen King from the League of Women Voters, Cory Taylor, Anthony Dunfee, Debbie Perry, Taylor Sappington and Sabrina Ennis Assistant Prosecutor.

Mr. Pettey led the pledge.

Ms. McGuckin moved, seconded by Mrs. Carpenter-Colvin that the minutes for July 10, July 26, August 8 and August 12, 2023 be approved by the Board as presented. Motion passed unanimously.
