BALLOT PROBLEMS REPORTED TO THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS A Small Number of Ballots Affected

A small number of voters have reported a problem with the ballots they received by mail from the Clark County Board of Elections. As of this morning, a few ballots have been reported as having a printing problem. For these few ballots, it appears that the ink did not set properly. The ballots were smudged and the ink will rub off in certain areas. These ballots were sent out in the initial mailing of approximately 20,000 ballots, and so far only a handful have been reported as having this problem. Any voter who receives a ballot in this condition should contact the Board of Elections at 937-521-2120 to have a new ballot mailed right away, or take their ballot to the early vote center at the Turner Studio Theatre at 300 S. Fountain Avenue in Springfield where they can either vote in person or hand carry a new ballot with them. We are very sorry for the inconvenience this will cause for some voters.
