

**LEGAL NOTICE OF REGISTRATION IN
DARKE COUNTY, OHIO**

In Compliance with Revised Code, Section 3503.12


SECTION 3503.01: Every citizen of the United States who is of the age of eighteen years or over and who has been a resident of the state thirty days immediately preceding the election at which the citizen offers to vote, is a resident of the county and precinct in which the citizen offers to vote, and has been registered to vote for thirty days, has the qualifications of an elector and may vote at all elections in the precinct in which the citizen resides.

SECTION 3503.07: Each person who will be of the age of eighteen (18) years or more at the next ensuing November election, who is a citizen of the United States, and who, if he continues to reside in the precinct until the next election, will at that time have fulfilled all the requirements as to length of residence to qualify him as an elector shall, unless otherwise disqualified, be entitled to be registered as an elector in such precincts. When once registered, an elector shall not be required to register again unless his registration is canceled.

Any person qualified to register may do so at the License Bureau, the Darke County Courthouse Treasurer's Office, any public library in Darke County, as well as the Board of Elections office. Registration forms may be downloaded from the Secretary of State's website: OhioSoS.gov or the Darke County Board of Elections website: boe.ohio.gov/darke. You may also register online from either of the above web addresses. Any qualified elector who completes a registration form must return the forms to the Board office no later than thirty (30) days before the election.

Completed registration forms must be in the possession of the Board of Elections no later than Monday, October 5, 2020, at 9:00 p.m. in order to be registered to vote in the upcoming General Election, Tuesday, November 3, 2020.
