

The post-election audit meeting of the Erie County Board of Elections was called to order by Chairman Thomas Ferrell on Friday, March 24th at 9:30 a.m.

Ms. Crescimano made a motion to go into recess while the bipartisan board staff conducts the post-election audit. Mr. Monaghan seconded the motion. All board members voted yes; motion carried.

Mr. Monaghan made a motion to reconvene with Ms. Crescimano seconding. All board members voted yes; motion carried. Board reconvened at 9:58 a.m.

Adrienne James, Deputy Director, reviewed the results of the post-election audit. She stated that we audited two machines, the Sandusky H & I DS200 and the Sandusky J & N DS200. We audited a total of 321 ballots out of 2,606 ballots cast, which is 12.31%. The results of our hand count match perfectly with the results from our election software. The board members, director, deputy director, and two clerks signed the post-election audit paperwork to submit to the Secretary of State’s office.

Ms. Crescimano made a motion to adjourn, with Mr. Monaghan seconding. All board members voted yes; motion carried. Board adjourned at 10:00 a.m.
