

The post-election audit meeting of the Erie County Board of Elections was called to order by Chairman Thomas Ferrell on Monday, August 28th, 2023 at 10:00 a.m.

Ms. Crescimano made a motion to recess while bipartisan board staff conducts the post-election audit. Mr. Monaghan seconded the motion. All board members voted yes; motion carried. Board recessed at 10:01 a.m.

At 10:36 a.m., the board returned to regular session. Adrienne James, Deputy Director, stated that staff audited two election day voting machines: the scanner from the Sandusky Cultural Center, which hosts Sandusky H and I, and the scanner from Ritter Public Library, which hosts Vermilion 1-A, 2-A, and 2-B. The results from our hand count match perfectly with the results from the scanners.

The board members took a few moments to review the audit tally sheets and sign the audit certification page. Mr. Monaghan made a motion to certify the results of the post-election audit, with Ms. Crescimano seconding. All board members voted yes; motion carried.

Ms. McKeen motioned to adjourn, with Mr. Monaghan seconding. All board members voted yes; motion carried. Board adjourned at 10:39 a.m.
