The deadline for voter registration for the November 2, 2021 General Election is Monday October 4, 2021. You may register by mail or in person at the following agencies or offices during their normal hours of operation: Jackson County Board of Elections, Ohio Secretary of State, Public Libraries, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, public high schools, vocational schools, Department of Health, Department of Human Services, Department of Mental Health, Department of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities, or Rehabilitation Services Commission. You may update your name, address or register online, by going to, Jackson Co Board of Elections website at <https://www.boe.ohio.gov/jackson/> once there click on the Registration Information tab, click on "Online Change of Address", "Register to Vote" or "Voter Registration Form" to print & mail or hand deliver your form to **our new office at 25 E. South St., Suite B, Jackson, Oh 45640 (In the back of Job & Family Services Building. Enter the LEFT DOOR)**

The Jackson County Board of Elections will conduct extended office hours for voter registration on Monday October 4, 2021. The office will be open from 8:00 A.M. until 9:00 P.M. All new voter registrations, address and or name changes **must be received or postmarked** by 9:00PM October 4, 2021 to be eligible to vote in the November 2, 2021 General Election.

To qualify to vote, you must be: a citizen of the United States; 18 years old on or before November 2, 2021; a resident of Ohio for at least 30 days immediately before Election Day; registered to vote at least 30 days before Election Day.

Early in person voting will begin Tuesday October 5, 2021 and will be conducted at the Jackson Co Board of Elections office at 25 E. South St, Suite B, Jackson, Ohio 45640.

The hours for voting are:

8:00am-5:00pm Tuesday October 5- Friday October 22;

8:00am-7:00pm Monday-Friday October 25-October 29;

8:00am-4:00pm Saturday October 30;

1:00pm-5:00pm Sunday October 31

The final day to vote early will begin at 8:00am and end at 2:00pm Monday November 1

Absentee ballots will begin being mailed out on October 5, 2021. Absentee ballots may be returned to the Board Office in person until Tuesday November 2 at 7:30pm. If they are being returned by mail they **must be postmarked by the Post Office** by midnight Monday November 1, 2021.
