The purpose of this meeting is to certify a Jersey Township Zoning Referendum Petition and other business brought before the Board.

Dave Rhodes made a motion to certify the petition has at least the minimum required valid and sufficient signatures. Melinda Miller provided the second. Motion carried 4-0.


**Adjournment and Next Meeting:**
