

LICKING COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
ELECTION DAY MEETING
MAY 3, 2022

An Election Day meeting of the Licking County Board of Elections was called to order at 6:30 A.M., with the following members present: Chairman Richard Salvage, Melinda Miller, Dave Rhodes. Also attending were Director Brian Mead and Deputy Director Luke Burton.

The purpose of this meeting is to conduct the unofficial canvass and other business brought before the Board.

Polls Open:

Chairman Richard Salvage declared the "polls open" at 6:30 A.M.

Chairman Richard Salvage led the Board in reciting the pledge of allegiance.

New Business:

Director Brian Mead and Deputy Director Luke Burton presented the Board with early voting totals.

Unfinished Business:

Dave Rhodes made a motion to certify the Township of Jersey Zoning Referendum to the November 8, 2022 ballot. Melinda Miller provided the second. Motion carried 3-0.

Recess/Reconvene:

The Board went into recess, scheduling to go back into session at 7:00 P.M.

The Board reconvened with Chairman Richard Salvage calling the meeting back to order at 7:05 P.M.

Unofficial Canvass:

A discussion began about observations made during the course of Election Day.

Further discussions began about the prospect of passing temporary chairmanship if an absence is needed. Public meetings may be held virtually on platforms similar to Zoom until June 30, 2022.

Chairman Richard Salvage declared the "polls closed" at 7:30 P.M.

The Unofficial Canvass began by tabulating all timely received absentee ballots. The process continued following Directive 2022-33 and all relevant sections of the Election Official Manual.
