

LICKING COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
ELECTION DAY MEETING
NOVEMBER 5, 2019

An Election Day meeting of the Licking County Board of Elections was called to order at 6:30 A.M., with the following members present: Chair Grace Cherrington, Melinda Miller, Richard Salvage, and Larry Wise. Also attending were Director Brian Mead and Deputy Director Luke Burton.

The purpose of this meeting is to conduct Election Day business and the Unofficial Canvass.

New Business:

No new business came before the Board.

- At 6:31 A.M. the Board went into recess.
- At 7:30 P.M. the Board reconvened.

Unofficial Canvass:

The Unofficial Canvass was conducted according to Directive 2019-24
The Unofficial Canvass began at 7:30 P.M. with the tabulation of all valid absentee ballots.
The first voting location arrived at 8:15 P.M. and the last arrived at 9:27 P.M.
28,655 Ballots were cast and counted on Election Day.
5,939 Absentee and UOCAVA ballots were counted.
422 Ballots remain outstanding including regular absentee and UOCAVA.
443 Total provisional ballots were cast. 77 during early voting and 366 on Election Day.
Deputy Director Burton presented the Board with final results for the Unofficial Canvass.
All reports required by Directive 2019-24 were signed and transmitted.

Adjournment and Next Meeting:

The Board scheduled a meeting to approve valid provisional ballots on November 18, 2019 at 4:30 P.M.

The Official Canvass of the November 5, 2019 General Election has been scheduled for November 26, 2019 at 4:30 P.M.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:30 P.M.
