

## **Voting Equipment Report May 7, 2019 Election**

In February 2019, Logan County purchased thirty-two (32) DS-200 optical scanners with ballot bins, fifteen (15) ExpressVote marking devices, and one (1) DS-450 central count scanner.

For the May 7, 2019 Primary/Special Election, the Logan County Board of Elections will be using thirty (30) of the optical scanners, thirteen (13) ExpressVote devices, and the central county scanner.

The Logan County Board of Elections has assigned one (1) optical scanner to each one thousand (1,000) registered voters at a polling location, one (1) optical scanner has been assigned for in-person absentee voting, one (1) optical scanner has been assigned to serve as the Public Test machine, and two (2) optical scanners will be utilized as spares in case of an issue at a polling location on Election Day.

The Logan County Board of Elections has assigned one (1) ExpressVote marking device to each polling location (representing twelve (12) ExpressVotes), one (1) has been assigned for absentee voting, and two (2) ExpressVote devices will be used as backup/replacement devices. Due to the minimal use of the previous ADA-assistive devices on previous Election Days, it is the conclusion of the Board of Elections that it is not necessary to allocate an ExpressVote to every precinct.

The total number registered voters in Logan County is 31,105. The attached list consists of all precincts along with the number of registered voters in each precinct and the voter turnout for a like elections (May 7, 2013 Election):
