

# **Marion County Board of Elections**

## **Special Board Meeting Minutes**

August 19, 2022

### **I. Call to Order**

Chair Todd Anderson called to order the special meeting of the Board of Elections at 4:51 PM on August 19, 2022 the meeting was held in the Prospect Room in the Marion County Building.

### **II. Attendance**

The following board members were present: Chair Todd Anderson, Brandi Downs, Lynn Zucker and Chris Smith. The Director and Deputy Director were also present.

### **III. Official Certification of 2022 August Primary Election**

- **Reports**

The Director presented the official summary of the August 2022 Primary Election.

Mrs. Downs made a motion to certify the August 2, 2022 Primary Election results. Ms. Smith seconded the motion. The board voted to accept the motion. Mrs. Zucker abstained due to her son on the ballot.

The Director presented certificates that required board signatures

### **IV. 2022 August Primary Election Post-Election Audit**

- **Date: August 24, 2022-9:00 AM**

The Post-Election Audit will be held on the Board of Elections Office.

- **Precinct Selection**

The Deputy Director presented the jar with the precincts for the audit. The board drew the following precincts for the August 24 - 9:00 AM post-election audit. The total number required is 177 and the board drew 208.

    - Marion Twp F: 57

- **Contests to Audit**

The Director stated they would like to audit. State Central Committee Democratic Women, State Central Committee Republican Man, and State Representative for the 86<sup>th</sup> District. Mrs. Downs made a motion to use Democratic Women, Republican Man, and 86<sup>th</sup> District for the contest audit. Ms. Smith seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously to accept the motion.

## V. Certification for November General Election

- **Candidates**

The Deputy Director stated Dr. Gary Burton has been selected by the Republican Party to fill Dr. Mark Davis position as Coroner on the ballot. Mrs. Zucker made a motion to accept the certification for Dr. Gary Burton to be on the ballot. Mrs. Downs seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously to accept the motion.

- **Questions and Issues**

The Director went over the list of questions and issues that will be on the November ballot.

- River Valley Local School District – Emergency 2.6 for 5 years
- Marion City Fire – Additional 2.75 Continuous
- Cardington Lincoln Public Library
- Prospect Village – Renewal 3.9 for 5 years
- Salt Rock Township – Replacement 3.0 for 5 years
- First Consolidated Fire District – 4.0 for 5 years
- Big Island Township – 2.0 for 5 years
- Waldo Village – Renewal 2.0 for 5 years

Ms. Smith made a motion to recognize the questions and issues that will be on the ballot. Mrs. Zucker seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously to accept the motion.

- **Local Options**

The Director presented the Local Options to the board. There has been a change with Local Options they only need 50 valid signatures to be placed on the ballot for Sunday Sales.

- Toby Smith LLC, dba TJ's Tobacco for Sunday Sales had 59 valid signatures. Mrs. Downs made a motion to accept Toby Smith LLC, dba TJ's Tobacco Local Option for the November ballot. Ms. Smith seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously to accept the motion.
- M City Imbibe, LLC, dba Shovel City Drinkery for Sunday Sales had 81 valid signatures. Mrs. Zucker made a motion to certify the petition for M City Imbibe, LLC, dba Shovel City Drinkery Local Option for the November ballot. Ms. Smith seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously to accept the motion.
- Country Folks Services, LLC, dba Raceway Mini Mart for Sunday Sales had 63 valid signatures. Ms. Smith made a motion to accept Country Folks Services, LLC, dba Raceway Mini Mart for Sunday Sales in Montgomery Township. Mrs. Downs seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously to accept the motion.

**VI. Additional Business**

- The Women League of Voters asked about the Candidates Guide laying on the counter by the back door. The board decided it would not be a good idea with early voting.
- Paula Kline asked about the Early Vote Center. Who gets to work it and why haven't other poll workers been asked to work? She also wanted to know why she was pulled as a Voting Location Manager at Elgin?
- Paula Kline Voting Location Manager at Elgin read a statement and discussion followed.
- A couple other poll workers read a statement and discussion followed. (Merle Dutt and Robert Landgrebe).
- McKinsey Collins Hall was also in attendance and a poll worker at Elgin.



**VII. Adjournment**


