

Marion County Board of Elections
Special Meeting Minutes

Purpose: For the automatic recount for Larue Village Council and 1ST Ward and
Post- Election Audit and Post- Election Public Test

December 2, 2019

I. Call to Order

Chair Lynn Zucker called the Special Meeting to order at 9:05AM on December 2, 2019 at the Board of Elections office.

II. Roll call

The following board members were present: Larry Heiser, Chair Lynn Zucker, Chris Smith, and Carolyn Weston, along with the Director and Deputy Director (guest sign in sheet copy attached).

III. Open the Recount

The director explained the automatic recount process.

Mr. Heiser made a motion to approve the automatic recount process. Ms. Smith seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously to approve the motion. Chair Lynn Zucker drew out 1-C to recount for the 1st ward. And Larue Village for Larue.

Ms. Smith made a motion to go into recess at 9:10AM and come back at 1:00PM. Mrs. Weston seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously to accept the motion.

Mr. Heiser made a motion to come out of recess at 9:11AM. Mrs. Weston seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously to come out of recess.

Ms. Smith made a motion to count a minimum of 2 precincts up to 5 percent for the Post- Election Audit. Mr. Heiser seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously to accept the motion. The total number needed is 574. Chair Zucker randomly pulled 5 precincts for the Post-Election Audit. The precincts are 3-C, 4-F, 3-G, 3-F, and MTD. These precincts add up to 614

Mr. Heiser made a motion to go back into recess at 9:18AM. Ms. Smith seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously to accept the motion.

The board came out of recess at 1:25PM. The Director stated that the Larue Village Council hand recount, was the same totals as of election night. The totals were David Stallsmith with 59 and John Howard with 59. Mr. Heiser made a motion to recertify the prior results 59 to 59. And the coin toss declaring Mr. David Stallsmith the winner. Ms. Smith seconded the motion. The board voted unanimously to accept the motion.

The next recount that was preformed was 1-C between Kai Meade and Michael Saad. Mrs. Weston made a motion to recertify Kai Meade the winner in the 1st ward, with Kai Meade at 277 and Michael Saad at 276. Ms. Smith seconded the motion. The board unanimously voted to accept the motion.

Mr. Heiser made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Smith seconded the motion. Chair Zucker adjourned the meeting at 1:50PM.


