

March 17, 2020

The Washington County Board of Elections met on March 17, 2020. Present were Mr. Sipe, Mr. Ray, Mr. Halliday, and Mr. Wentz, Mandy Amos, Director, and Karen Pawloski, Deputy Director. Four members of the Washington County Sheriff's Office were in attendance.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Chairman Sipe opened the meeting at 5:31 a.m. for the purpose of notifying the voters of Washington County of the Ohio Secretary of State Directive 2020-06 that suspends the Presidential Primary for March 17, 2020. This Directive postponed the election until June 2, 2020 due to the Ohio Health Director closing specific public places due to the virus COVID-19. The Washington County Sheriff's office allowed the Board members to be accompanied by Deputy Officers to place notices at all Washington County Polling locations. Mr. Halliday made a motion to recess until 7:00 a.m. when the Board returns. Mr. Ray seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Wentz to come back into session at 9:00 a.m. Mr. Ray seconded the motion. Motion carried.


Mr. Sipe said the Board members posted notice by the SoS and a copy of the Directive to each polling location. The election was moved to June 2, 2020. Pictures were taken to prove the notices were delivered and posted. Mr. Sipe said he wanted to make sure that Washington County voters knew that all votes taken up to March 16 at Noon, were safe and locked in a double lock in a bi-partisan manner. The sanctity of those votes are important and will be counted but not before polls close on June 2, 2020 at 7:30 p.m.

Chairman Sipe asked for motions to adjourn. Mr. Halliday gave the motion and Mr. Ray seconded the motion. Motion Carried.


The next meeting will be on April 9, 2020 at 6:30 am.


