
The Washington County Board of Elections held a special meeting November 3, 2020 at 6:00 a.m. Present were Mr. Sipe, Mr. Wentz, Mr. Ray, and Mandy Amos, Director. Deputy Director Pawloski was en route to Reno Polling location to take codes so they can open the poll books. Members of the public were Adam Schwendemen, an official Observer.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and Chairman Sipe opened the meeting for Election Day 2020. The Board went into recess. The Board came back from recess at 1:50 a.m. on November 4, 2020. Three Board members were present, Mr. Sipe, Ms. Ritter, and Mr. Wentz. Mr. Wentz made a motion they accept the unofficial count of 31,687 ballots cast, 74.08% for the 11.3.2020 Election. Ms. Ritter seconded the motion and the motion carried.


Chairman Sipe then asked for a motion to adjourn. Mr. Wentz gave the motion and Ms. Ritter seconded the motion – the motion carried.

Next Meeting will be on November 16, 2020 at 8:30 am. This meeting will serve as regular monthly meeting.


